HEALTH CARE SERVICES

The neurologists and neurosurgeons of the **Spine & Neuroscience Center** tackle brain, spine and nervous system conditions ranging from simple to complex. Our experts collaborate with UM SOM faculty at UM BWMC and via telehealth to advance discovery-driven treatments. The surgeons and specialists pursue conservative care plans, first exhausting non-surgical treatment options. When appropriate, the team deploys the most advanced surgical techniques to help patients have better health outcomes.

Equipped with leading edge technology and expertise in invasive and non-invasive interventions, the **Cardiac Care** team at UM BWMC diagnoses and treats the full spectrum of heart conditions. With on-site diagnostic testing, specialized clinics, a state-of-the-art catheterization laboratory and a cardiopulmonary rehabilitation program, our heart specialists are prepared to treat even the most complex heart condition. In collaboration with specialists and UM SOM faculty from across the medical system, our team meets all patients' heart care needs.

The **Tate Cancer Center** offers patients individualized treatment plans and coordinated care. A multidisciplinary team of surgeons, medical and radiation oncologists, pathologists, nurse navigators and other health care professionals collaborate to develop the most appropriate and effective treatment plan. The Tate Cancer Center's affiliation with the University of Maryland Marlene and Stewart Greenebaum Comprehensive Cancer Center affords patients access to leading-edge clinical trials and specialists at the National Cancer Institute-designated cancer center in Baltimore.

The **Aiello Breast Center** provides comprehensive care that addresses a patient's physical and emotional well-being through a streamlined approach to education, detection, diagnosis and treatment of both malignant and nonmalignant disease, genetic counseling and reconstructive surgery.

The pulmonologists and advanced practice providers at the **Lung Center** at UM BWMC provide comprehensive treatment of lung, airway, chest and pulmonary vascular conditions. In collaboration with the cancer and cardiac teams, the **Interventional Pulmonology** team at UM BWMC uses minimally invasive techniques to diagnose and treat a range of conditions, including nodules and fluid buildup, and works closely with our **Thoracic Surgery** team to provide curative treatment.

The **Pascal Women's Center** is home to UM BWMC's obstetrics unit where our obstetricians, midwives and nurses provide first-class care to mothers and their newborns. The center features private labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum rooms, dedicated operating rooms for cesarean births and a level II nursery for newborns who need special care from the team of neonatal nurses, nurse practitioners and pediatricians. The center is also home to a satellite office of the University of Maryland Center for Advanced Fetal Care.

With four locations across the county, our **Primary Care** providers maintain long-term relationships with patients through compassionate preventive and diagnostic care, education and support. Our providers work closely with specialists to help patients manage their overall health as well as chronic conditions such as diabetes.

The **Population Health** team supports patients as they transition from the hospital to primary care practices, connecting them to social and medical services in the community, removing common barriers to health and wellness.

UM BWMC's **Community Outreach Program** engages community members close to home. UM BWMC offers blood drives, wellness events, free screenings and support groups to help families in our area to thrive and stay well. The medical center also partners with community organizations to host wellness events and vaccination clinics.
