University of Maryland Baltimore Washington Medical Center (UM BWMC) provides comprehensive primary and specialty health care to residents of Anne Arundel County and the surrounding region. As part of the University of Maryland Medical System, UM BWMC's expert physicians and experienced, compassionate staff are connected to medical practices in the local community as well as at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. For patients, this means access to high-quality care and research discoveries aimed at improving Maryland's health.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES

The **Tate Cancer Center** offers patients nearly all of their treatment and care in one location through an individualized treatment plan. A multidisciplinary team of surgeons, medical and radiation oncologists, pathologists, nurse navigators and other health care professionals collaborate to develop the most appropriate and effective strategy for care. The Tate Cancer Center's affiliation with the University of Maryland Marlene and Stewart Greenebaum Comprehensive Cancer Center affords patients access to leading-edge clinical trials and specialists at the National Cancer Institute-designated cancer center in Baltimore.

The **Aiello Breast Center** provides comprehensive care that addresses a patient's physical and emotional well-being through a streamlined approach to education, detection, diagnosis and treatment of both malignant and nonmalignant disease, genetic counseling and reconstructive surgery.

The **Vascular Center** is home to internationally recognized specialists and offers a full-service vascular laboratory to treat conditions including peripheral vascular disease, abdominal aortic aneurysms and cerebrovascular disease. An advanced endovascular suite offers minimally invasive vascular treatments using a highly advanced patient-monitoring system and state-of-the-art intravascular ultrasound system.

The **Cardiac Care** team provides a range of diagnostic and interventional services, including angioplasty, cardiac catheterization and critical care. UM BWMC is designated a Cardiac Interventional Center (CIC) by the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS).

The neurologists and neurosurgeons of the **Spine & Neuroscience Center** tackle brain, spine and nervous system conditions using the most advanced minimally invasive techniques. A 3D navigational system and intraoperative computer-assisted imaging makes brain and spine surgery safer than ever.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES

At UM BWMC's **Joint Replacement Center**, orthopaedic surgeons provide comprehensive, team-focused care to patients before, during and after joint replacement surgery.

In the **Emergency Department**, UM BWMC's team of physicians, physician assistants, nurses and support staff care for more than 60,000 patients of all ages every year.

The **Pascal Women's Center** is home to UM BWMC's obstetrics unit where our obstetricians, midwives and nurses provide first-class care to mothers and their newborns. The center features private labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum rooms, dedicated operating rooms for cesarean births, and a level II nursery for newborns who need special care from the team of neonatal nurses, nurse practitioners and pediatricians. The center is also home to a satellite office of the University of Maryland Center for Advanced Fetal Care.

The **University of Maryland Center for Diabetes and Endocrinology** provides comprehensive care for people with diabetes and endocrine issues, such as thyroid and metabolic disorders, and focuses on preventing and managing the multiple effects of diabetes.

UM BWMC's **Community Outreach Program** recognizes that the role of a hospital extends beyond its physical walls. UM BWMC offers blood drives, wellness events, free screenings and support groups to help families in our area to thrive and stay well. The medical center also partners with community organizations to host vaccination clinics.

QUALITY AND RECOGNITION

- The **Maryland Patient Safety Center** recognized UM BWMC with the top two honors at the 2023 Minogue Awards for Patient Safety Innovation, a first in the program's history. UM BWMC received the Patient Safety Innovation Award, the Distinguished Achievement for Patient Safety Innovation Award, and a Circle of Honor recognition.

- The Tate Cancer Center at UM BWMC is an **accredited Academic Comprehensive Cancer Program by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer**, an achievement only 13 percent of all cancer programs in the nation have accomplished.
