Was most recent COVID test PCR? *For symptomatic patient only* – if no PCR must have two positive rapid antigen tests within 5 days of sx onset - performed 30 minutes apart with two different swabs *Valid tests include: Veritor, Sofia, Abbott Binax now, Lumira, CareStart, Sampinute	Must have PCR (preferred) or 2 rapid antigens that qualify ←

KEEP IN MIND: *We now accept patients who have diagnosed positive within PAST THREE MONTHS - PCR ONLY that must be verifiable via CRISP - who may benefit from our services (even if they have had a more recent negative result)*

**If patient presented to the ER with a PSYCH or behavioral complaint OR required sitter/emergency meds/restraints, must have psych consult within the ER prior to transfer and notify psych NP for evaluation at BCCFH*

Physical Ability (AM-PAC Score)*** See new guideline below	Ideal ≥ 19; nursing OK if 13-18; do not admit ≤ 12
