

## Breast Cancer Screening FAQ's: After Making an Appointment

1. What should I wear on the day of the screening?
  - a. Do not wear any powder, perfumes, or deodorants under your arms or in the breast area
  - b. Wear clothing that is easy for you to remove (you will need to undress from the waist up)
2. What should I bring the day of the event?
  - a. A photo ID
  - b. A copy of your last mammogram (if you've had one)
3. When will I get my results?
  - a. Normal results: you will receive a letter in the mail from Advanced Radiology within 2 weeks
  - b. Abnormal results: you will receive a phone call and a letter in the mail from Advanced Radiology within 2 weeks
4. Who will get my results?
  - a. Advanced Radiology, UM Baltimore Washington Medical Group Women's Health, and you
  - b. You should send your results to your personal primary care doctor
5. What if follow-up is needed?
  - a. Advanced Radiology will call you if more testing is needed
6. When should I have my next mammogram?
  - a. Normal results: in one year
  - b. Abnormal results: Advanced Radiology will call you
7. Who do I call if I find a lump or have other symptoms between now and my next mammogram?
  - a. Make an appointment with your gynecologist or primary care provider
