To Our Patients,

Thank you for being a patient at University of Maryland Baltimore Washington Medical Center. This handout will provide you with instructions for receiving **health care assistance** once you leave UM BWMC. This handout will also provide you with **resources for food, shelter, and emergency assistance**. For substance abuse issues, please refer to our Substance Abuse referral packet.

For patients **without health insurance** benefits we recommend the following:

Anne Arundel County Warmline: 410-768-5522

This is the County’s Crisis Response System. They are a crisis/referral line that is available to you 24 hours a day 7 days a week. They provide urgent care appointments with therapists or psychiatrists within a timely manner. They also provide several services including, but not limited to: crisis intervention, help with issues related to homelessness, medication assistance, and on-going outpatient treatment. They are knowledgeable about a variety of services in the county that can assist you.

Maryland Public Behavioral Health System: 1-800-888-1965

Beacon Health can be reached 24 hours a day. They have access to a long list of behavioral health providers and will give approval for treatment. They **do not** provide assistance for referrals to substance abuse counseling.

Provides medical, OB/GYN, dental, behavioral health, pharmacy, and case management services.

Should your symptoms worsen and you experience thoughts of suicide and/or homicide, go immediately to the nearest emergency room or call 911. University of Maryland Baltimore Washington Medical Center, Anne Arundel Medical Center and Harbor Hospital can all evaluate behavioral health/psychiatric conditions.

Resources for Obtaining Prescription Medication

- Check with your insurance company to see if you have a prescription benefit.
- www.goodrx.com: This website can assist with showing you the cost and help you find the cheapest place to get the medication and sometimes offers coupons for the medication.
- If you do not have the money to pay for the entire month's prescription, you may have part of it filled and go back to get the remainder later. Pharmacies vary regarding the price of medication and you may wish to call to compare prices.
- **Anne Arundel County Mental Health Agency 410-222-7858**
If you are an Anne Arundel County resident and are being treated by a psychiatrist and do not have money for psychiatric medications, your doctor or clinic can apply for assistance through the Anne Arundel County Mental Health Agency. First, you must complete the application for Medical Assistance. If you qualify, the AA County Mental Health Agency can send a one-time supply of medication for a month *to your provider* to then give to you. Ask your psychiatrist or mental health provider to apply. Your provider can then call to further assist you. Patients can call directly for assistance with housing, childcare, and adult aftercare.
- **Crofton Christian Caring Council**
Churches in the area have formed a consortium to provide emergency services, including prescription help. Please see the website <http://www.seaseton.org/outreach/crofton-christian-caring-council.html> for information on where and when to go and which church to call. Residents of Crofton, Crownsville, Gambrills, Millersville, and Odenton are served by this council.
- **Department of Social Services** may help with prescriptions for medical problems. They do not assist with psychiatric medication. Anne Arundel County DSS is (410) 269-4500.
- **Drug Company Vouchers**
Some companies, which produce medication, have financial assistance or vouchers for the medication. Ask your doctor or pharmacy if they have vouchers. You can also ask which drug company makes the medication. Then call the company and see if you there is a prescription assistance program. It may take several weeks to apply for this type of assistance.
- **Healthcare for the Homeless 410-837-5533**
421 Fallsway Baltimore MD 21202
Located in Baltimore City, this agency can provide health care and fill prescriptions for you. The physician there must see you before assisting with prescriptions. You must go there to seek assistance in person. You may call for an appointment.
- **Medical Assistance** will cover medications. If you do not have this and wish to apply for Medical Assistance you may call the Department of Social Services for an application. The Anne Arundel County office located in Glen Burnie can be reached at **410-421-8500**.
- **Medicare Part D** covers part of the cost of most prescriptions. You must sign-up for a Part D prescription option. Contact Medicare for more information: **1-800-MEDICARE (633-4227)**. Have your Medicare number handy.

- **North County Emergency Outreach Network (NCEON) 410-766-1826**
Open Monday, Wednesday and Friday 10am-2pm
 304 5th Ave Glen Burnie (at Community Church of God). You must come in person with original prescription and ID. Assistance can be provided every three months for residents of Glen Burnie, Hanover, Harmons, Linthicum, Millersville, Pasadena, Orchard Beach and Severn.

Open Monday through Thursday 10am-2pm

 Assistance provided once in a 12 month period for residents of Arnold, Broadneck, Millersville, and Severna Park. You must come in person with original prescription and ID. Residents from Fort Meade, Glen Burnie, Linthicum, Pasadena, and Severn provided assistance with referral from North County Emergency Outreach Network NEON (see above). Residents from Crofton, Crownsville, Gambrills, and Odenton provided assistance with referral from Crofton Christian Caring Counsel (CCCC).
- **Wal-Mart and Target** has an extensive supply of medications for \$4.00 per prescription. CVS, Rite Aid, and Walgreens also have prescription savings programs (UMBWMC has no affiliation with any of these companies)

- Community Recovery Center offers: substance and alcohol twelve step meetings, such as Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) and Narcotics Anonymous (NA) meetings, social skills workshops access to vocational training and literacy courses. They also offer various support groups including: peer-led support groups, trauma support groups, gender specific groups, parenting classes, and mental health education and support groups.
- The Fouse Center: Transitional housing program for men offering intensive mental health and substance abuse support, employment assistance, adult education, and health referrals.
 - Special Contact: Charity Cummings - Fouse Center at ccummings@arundelhoh.org and Community Housing Case Manager at cthomas@arundelhoh.org or call (410) 863-4888.
- Patriot House: Veteran housing program for six veterans and one live-in staff member. Residents may stay for up to two years with goal of transitioning back to independent living.

- Permanent Housing: Stable, long-term, independent housing for homeless and disabled men. Residents must be able to pay a subsidized rent and be able to live in a community housing situation with other men.
- Resource and Day Center: Day center for men, women, and children experiencing homelessness. All are welcome and encouraged, no restrictions.
 - Monday through Friday 8:30 – 5:00pm and Saturday 8:30 – 4pm.
 - Indoor day shelter, safety, shower, used clothing
 - Case management
 - Phone use, mailboxes
 - Housing search assistance
 - Recovery meetings and support groups on
 - Referrals to outside agencies for more advanced needs (mental health care, detox/rehab, job counseling and placement assistance, free legal aid, etc)
- Safe Haven/W.I.S.H.: Housing-first model supportive housing program. The Safe Haven Program serves only those who qualify as being chronically homeless, or homeless for a period of one year or longer, or four or more times in three consecutive years. Individuals must have some form of income, either through employment or government benefits, as they pay subsidized rent. In addition, they must be able to live in a community environment.

- Winter Relief Shelter: Individuals seeking shelter must be screened through the Anne Arundel County Coordinated Entry screening process by calling 410-417-7260 and leaving your name and contact information for a return call. If accepted a van will transport clients to a church for the night for shelter. The shelter will be hosted by a different church each week OR at an “Alternate Emergency Shelter” at a local hotel. **Criteria and instructions for approval change with each year. Please call main number (410-863-4888) for the most updated instructions.**

We believe that people will rise to a better life when they begin to believe they have something of value to give back by serving others.
