The surgical team was remarkably good. From start to finish I was comfortable in what was to take place. The explanations given by RN Tyler Team Lead were excellent and made me quite comfortable. Having not had a lot of sleep the night before that was a really nice nap Dr. Kleinert induced. I only had a brief visit with Wendy but she was instrumental in changing the IV from my port to regular insertion in my hand. I'm sure she was remarkable during surgery.

When I arrived in the recovery area, nurse Erica and Tech Thelma were attentive to my every need. They were most helpful when I needed to get out of bed. In fact they made it quite clear I was not to get out of bed without their assistance.

I mentioned this when I spoke to you on the phone on Thursday the day after the surgery. The care I have received from Shore Health over the past eighteen months or so have been excellent. I often hear complaints from some of the folks in my community. I think a lot of them are just old and grumpy. Almost without exception my experience with the hospital has been exemplary. I have written a separate letter to the Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Huffner expressing my feelings.
