It is impossible to fully predict the support or comfort you may need during a time of great stress and

uncertainty. But it is remarkable when someone exceeds your needs and cares for you in a way beyond what you could've imagined.

After the delivery of our daughter three full weeks early, my wife had to be readmitted due to complications and I was left caring for our newborn for several days on the Pediatrics Unit. The nights were very difficult. My wife was stressed and upset being separated from me and our baby, and I was left taxed with caring for our newborn by myself. This is where our nurse Donna stepped in. Not only did she handle several late night feedings and care allowing me to rest and recover, she showered our daughter Grace with a care and deep affection far beyond what we expected.

On a personal level, she deeply related to the stresses we were going through being separated not only as a married couple, but as a mother from her newborn daughter, and as parents from our other children at home.

The comfort and reassurance she provided gave us a profound peace and will forever be lasting in our lives. We are grateful for her impact on our daughter and our family.
