BASE STATION CONSULT

What is important?

- **Last Known Well** - available stroke treatments are dependent on the last time the patient was without symptoms.
- **Priority 1 - all stroke patients**
- Cincinnati/LAMS
- Use verbiage "STROKE ALERT"

Why is this important?

Activates the Stroke/Brain Attack Team at the Stroke Center
