




Intensivists	• CAUTIs, CLABSIs, Sepsis , Shock, Pneumothorax	Better
Surgeons/Anesthesia	 Postoperative (Surgical Site) Infection, Hemorrhage/Hematoma with Control Procedure, Aspiration Pneumonias, Pneumothorax 	Patient Outcomes = Better
Emergency Department	 Accidental Puncture/Laceration, Procedural Misadventures, Sepsis, Shock 	
Interventional Radiology	 Pneumothorax, Accidental Puncture/Laceration, Procedural Misadventures 	
Obstetrics & Gynecology	 Abdominopelvic Accidental Puncture/Laceration 	
Cardiology	• Respiratory Failure, Shock	

Where should we focus?

Hospitalists	 Skin assessments, Get Patients OOB, Monitor Fluid Status, Monitor for SIRS, Timely Antibiotics 	
Intensivists	 Discontinue/Avoid Central Lines and Foleys, Monitor for SIRS, Goals of Care Conversations with Families 	<section-header></section-header>
Surgeons/Anesthesia	 Preoperative fluid status, Pre/PostOp Anticoagulation Status, Wound Care Nurse Collaboration, Ultrasound for CVCs 	
Emergency Department	 Timely recognition of Sepsis, Simulation Courses and Practicing High Risk Procedures 	
Interventional Radiology	Universal Protocol	
Obstetrics & Gynecology	 Simulation Courses and Practicing High Risk Procedures 	
Cardiology	 Diagnosing CHF, BP/HR & Fluid Management, Cardiac Clearance
