Wound Care Orders Now Available Electronically for More Efficient and Clinically Appropriate Ordering

WHO: Providers who manage patients with wounds and/or skin care needs

WHAT: New Order Sets:

- Wound & Skin Initial Care
- Wound & Skin Comprehensive
- Wound Ostomy Care
- Wound NegPressureTherapy (NPWT)

WHY: To support more efficient ordering processes surrounding wound/skin care and offer evidence-based clinical decision support to ordering providers managing complicated skin issues. *Let's get wound care started SOONER!*

WHEN: March 4, 2019

STEPS:

- Provider should utilize appropriate order set depending on skin condition. Search Order Sets using "wound" and order set choices will display.
- Follow the prompts and respect any required fields denoted by *asterisks.
- Be on the lookout for orders entered by Wound/Ostomy nurses. They will also be using order sets with provider consultation and eSign.

Dry/Wet/Infected/Comprehensive Wounds

- The entering provider has the option to select the same treatment for each wound or an individualized treatment for each wound
 - A blank wound will ALWAYS appear last on each order
