



UM UCH Departmental Uniform Guidelines

Licensed Practical Nurses and Registered Nurses:

- Top – may be white, solid color, or multi-colored scrub or approved shirt
- Jacket – may be white, solid color, or multi-colored
- Note: If a top and jacket are worn together, one of the two must be white
- Bottom – solid white scrub pants, skirt, or dress

EEG, Heart and Vascular Institute, Imaging, Laboratory, Patient Care Technicians, Respiratory Therapy, and Unit Secretaries:

- Top – may be white, solid color or multi-colored scrub or approved shirt
- Jacket – may be white, solid shade of approved navy blue or multi-colored
- Note: If a top and jacket are worn together, one of the two must be an approved shade of navy blue
- Bottom – solid in an approved shade of navy blue in either a scrub pants, skirt, or dress

Inpatient Rehabilitation:

- Khaki scrub bottoms with black scrub top

Outpatient Rehabilitation:

- Khaki, black or gray scrub bottoms with black, red or white scrub top

Sitters and Transporters:

- All navy blue scrubs, top and bottom

Pulmonary and Cardiac Rehabilitation, and The Joint Center:

- Bottom – khakis may be worn in combination with guidelines listed above

Anticoagulation, Cath Lab, Central Sterile, Family Birthplace, Perioperative Services, Pharmacy, Physician Practices and Senator Bob Hooper House:
