

### **Strategies**

- Deliver safe, highly reliable and valuebased care in a secure healing environment steered by the principles of a High Reliability Organization (HRO).
- Ensure an exceptional patient and family experience by partnering with patients to provide dynamic, cooperative and equitable care.
- Improve physical and virtual care delivery by optimizing access points and patient flow, redesigning bed-type allocation and enhancing outpatient care efficiency.
- Become a destination health care employer for top talent by fostering a culture of excellence and by focusing on job enrichment, advancement, and wellness.
- Strengthen the clinical enterprise by aligning the hospital and physician organization to be a model for the nation as a top quartile quality performer.
- Develop long-term financial and performance improvement plans to deepen investment in clinical programs, the workforce, the community and strategic capital needs.
- Bolster collaborative, donor-centric fundraising and development initiatives.

- Advance discovery of lifesaving medicine by increasing access to and participation in clinical trials.
- Reduce the time from research discovery
  to bedside care by increasing access to
  clinical trials in programs such as cancer care,
  addiction medicine, and xenotransplantation,
  as well as programs specific to West
  Baltimore communities like sarcoidosis and
  sickle cell disease.
- Renew National Institutes of Health (NIH)
   National Cancer Institute (NCI) comprehensive cancer center designation.
- Grow number of grants, contract revenue and submission rates.
- Recruit prominent physician-scientist thought leaders recognized regionally and nationally for making significant contributions within their specialties.
- Prioritize programs that catapult University
  of Maryland academic health care partners
  into the competitive future of Learning
  Health Care Systems, "smart" hospitals,
  precision medicine, population health and
  multi-omics systems biology.

- In partnership with University of Maryland, Baltimore schools, develop and implement multi-year strategy to enhance trainee education and experience, and maximize opportunities for trainees to pursue careers within UMMC and UMSOM.
- Increase opportunities for trainees to gain experience in health care leadership and administration, including programs related to leadership development, diversity and inclusion and High Reliability Organization (HRO) practices.

- Develop a multi-service centralized health care delivery model to improve primary care, chronic disease management, and care coordination between caregivers, services and patients.
- Expand West Baltimore partnerships with federally qualified health centers to improve patient access and student-supported clinics at Mondawmin Mall.
- Recruit Senior Associate Dean for Population Health and Community Medicine to lead operations and strategic partnerships.
- Leverage innovative care models to expand care for our communities and maximize funding.
- Implement the University of Maryland Career Academy to foster economic well-being.
