Resident Resources and Support

Neurosurgery residents need the proper tools and materials to succeed in their training. At the University of Maryland, residents are provided with the following:

- Personalized lead suit for operative and angiography needs
- \$3,000 in residency to purchase loupes, a personal headlamp if desired, a computer, books
 - The operating rooms also provide general use headlamps
- \$1,250 yearly for software, books, education materials, and courses
- MedOne Neurosurgery subscription to access the latest neurosurgery books on an electronic device
- Complementary required neurosurgery textbooks
- Complementary membership to AANS and CNS
- Yearly budget for personalized UMD Neurosurgery gear/apparel
- Complementary yearly parking across the Shock Trauma Center entrance
- Complementary yearly University of Maryland, Baltimore Pratt Gym membership. The gym is across from the hospital and includes a pool, three levels of equipment, basketball courts, and a running track.
- Cell phone reimbursement plan
- Covered fees for ABNS and Neuroanatomy examinations
- Covered fees for SNS bootcamps, Goodman Course, RUNN Course
- Travel and hotel coverage for accepted oral presentations to national meetings
