## EDUCATIONAL GOALS:

- 1. Demonstrate ability to interpret peripheral blood smear
- 2. Appropriate technique and understanding of results for bone marrow biopsy
- 3. Demonstrate understanding of normal mechanism of hemostasis and effect of systemic disease on hemostasis
- 4. Demonstrate knowledge of diagnosis and management of inherited and acquired coagulopathies
- 5. Demonstrate appropriate diagnostic work-up for hypercoagulable state and appropriate use of the various available anticoagulant agents
- 6. Diagnosis and management of thrombocytopenia in hospitalized patients
- 7. Evaluation of pancytopenia in hospitalized patients
- 8. Diagnosis and management of acute complications of sickle cell anemia and other hemoglobinopathies
- 9. Diagnosis and management of erythrocytosis, leukocytosis and thrombocytosis
- 10. Demonstrate understanding of hematologic issues in HIV-positive patients
- 11. Demonstrate ability to discuss indications and complications of available blood products and therapeutic plasma exchange
- 12. Demonstrate understanding of hematologic issues in pregnancy
- 13. Timely documentation of consult note and communication with referring teams
- 14. Obtain relevant medical records from patient's primary care providers or outside hematologists
- 15. Demonstrate motivation towards self-learning
