They can also add any curriculum that is not necessarily related to a particular service/rotation, but for purposes relative to the program and/or the institution. They also have the ability to see who downloaded the curriculum goals/objectives for a particular service/rotation. These goals and objectives will appear for all trainees as well as faculty members on their main portal or Home page. They can also work with their program coordinator to determine when they want these goals and objectives sent to their trainees via e-mail before the service or rotation begins. MedHub can send these e-mails out automatically once it's determined when these goals should be distributed.
