## Monday:

## 1200

Transplant Grand Rounds, a variety of topics all directly related to abdominal transplantation are presented by specialists in their respective fields, including surgical and medical management of the donors and recipients, intensive and outpatient care of the perioperative patient, transplant immunology, transplant pathology, and transplant infectious disease. This conference includes both basic and clinical science research from both internal and external experts.

Surgery M&M. Traditional academic departmental M&M, with fellows and residents presenting cases with complication

Surgery Grand Rounds. Traditional academic departmental Grand Rounds with broad focus and typically given by outside experts.

Liver Multidisciplinary Listing Meeting. Presentation and discussion of potential liver recipients.

Liver At-risk meeting. Discussion and management strategy session for patients deemed to be at high risk of liver allograft loss within the first year of transplant.

Liver Pathology Conference. All liver transplant biopsies, explants, and pre-transplant liver biopsies are reviewed at the microscope with our pathology and hepatology colleagues.

## Friday:

## 1200

Transplant M&M. The fellows are expected to present patients experiencing complications, with a subsequent analysis for cause and action plan to avoid complications in the future.

Kidney/Pancreas Pathology Conference. All kidney and pancreas transplant biopsies, explants, and pretransplant renal biopsies are reviewed at the microscope with our pathology and nephrology colleagues.

Kidney Multidisciplinary Listing Meeting. Presentation and discussion of potential kidney recipients.
